ADE, DGTL and Young Creators present first global hackathon for the dance scene.

To stimulate innovation and entrepreneurship in the dance and festival scene, ADE 2016 will see DGTL, Young Creators and ADE joining forces to organize the first ever ADE Hackathon. As the electronic music scene is using data & technology more and more, the three parties acknowledge that it is of importance to discover further opportunities.

At the ADE Hackathon, smart developers, designers and entrepreneurs are asked to think along. A group of 100 selected bright minds is invited to develop smart concepts, new apps and inspiration within a challenging timespan of 24 hours with data, technology and information provided.
